

## Spill Response

### Report pesticide spills if it is:

5 gallons or more

100 dry pounds or more

(includes formulated products, dilutants, and other additives)

Report pesticide spills to the Department of Agriculture within 48 hours

Contact your local Disaster and Emergency Services (DES)

or the state DES office: 406-841-3911

### Reporting Requirements

Location

- Legal description
- Address
- Landmarks

Pesticides(s) Name

- Manufacturer's name

Quantity Spilled

Name of Primary Contact

- Address & telephone numbers

### Control the pesticide spill:

Identify source of spill

Wear proper personal protective equipment (PPE)

Divert spills away from water, drains, sewers, etc.

### Contain the Pesticide spill:

Dike the spill with absorbent material

- Soil, sand, kitty litter
- Chemical absorbent "pigs"

Never hose down the spill area until clean up is completed

### Clean Up Pesticide Spill:

Recapture any useable material

Absorb any residual liquid material

For contaminated soil –

Remove all damp soil plus three additional inches

Contain contaminated soil to prevent further contamination

Once the cleanup is completed then clean the spill sites (paved or cement surfaces only)

With detergent and water.
